

Exodus Refugee Volunteer Bill of Rights

As a volunteer serving with Exodus Refugee Immigration, you have the right:

...To be assigned a meaningful task.

...To be oriented, trained and supervised during the duration of your activity.

...To ask questions about your task and receive feedback about your performance.

...To be always treated with respect and kindness by every member of the organization for which you volunteer.

...To offer input and feedback to the organization about the job or task you are performing to improve your situation and the needs of other volunteers.

...To be trusted with confidential information which may be necessary to fulfill your task.

...To expect that your time will be used efficiently and effectively.

...To be thanked for the work that you do and not be taken for granted.
