




Planned Giving

When you give to Exodus, you give refugees hope for the life ahead.

There are so many ways to make a planned gift to Exodus. Here are some of the easiest ways you can give:

Bequests

Including Exodus in your will or living trust is one of the easiest ways to ensure that you have the resources you need to support yourself and your family while building a future for refugees. You can leave Exodus a set amount, a percent of your estate, or the remainder of your estate after other bequests--such as those to family members--have been fulfilled.

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Life Insurance Plans and Retirement Accounts
