Post 2024 Election Answers for Parolees

What should I do now to ensure I can remain in the U.S.?

You should pursue an alternative status, such as TPS (temporary protected status), asylum, or another form of more permanent relief.

If I already have parole, can it be taken away? If so, when?

Yes. The executive branch can take parole away from those who currently have it. The president can do this at any time.

Will my parole be renewed?

While we cannot be certain, it is unlikely that the Trump administration will renew parole for anyone.

Can I be deported if I have parole?

Yes. The executive branch can revoke parole without notice and place those who have it in removal proceedings. You would still have the right to a hearing before an immigration judge.

Are there certain documents I should carry to prove I'm here legally?

You can carry your EAD.
